Driving Directions to Catholic Theological Union:

Lake Shore Drive (from the south)

Take Lake Shore Drive north.
Exit at 57th Street.
Go west on 57th St. to Hyde Park Boulevard.
Turn north (right) on Hyde Park Boulevard and proceed to 54th Street.
Turn west (left) on 54th Street to Cornell Ave.

Lake Shore Drive (from the north)

Take Lake Shore Drive south.
Exit at 53rd Street.
Go west on 53rd St. to Cornell Avenue.
Turn south (left) on Cornell Avenue and proceed to 54th Street.

Dan Ryan (I90-94) (from north or south)

Exit at Garfield Boulevard (55th Street).
Turn east on Garfield Boulevard and continue east bound.
In Washington Park, follow the sign for 55th Street.
Turn east (right) on 55th and proceed east to Cornell Avenue.
Turn north (left) on Cornell Avenue and proceed to 54th Street.

Chicago Skyway (I-90)

Exit at Stony Island.
Take Stony Island north to 56th Street.
Turn east (right) on 56th to Cornell Avenue.
Turn north (left) on Cornell Avenue and proceed to 54th Street.

Parking Garage Instructions

The parking garage is located to the south of the new academic building which is on the west side of Cornell Ave. Turn in at the driveway to the garage. Press the button on the box on the parking garage kiosk. Tell the receptionist you are attending the Pathways Awareness/Emmaus Program workshop. The receptionist will raise the parking garage arm for you. Park your car. Use the elevator or walk to the ground floor exit door to Cornell Avenue next to the overhead garage door. Turn left on Cornell to the main entrance and the receptionist will buzz you in to enter the building. Use the stairs or the elevators to your left to go to the second floor. Registration for the workshop will be in the 2nd floor lobby area next to the stairwell. Registrars will direct you to room 210 B and C.
